

Watercolor: Basic Techniques

Bleed (Wet-on-Wet) - A wet brush on wet paper






Lift - Press objects into wet paint and lift









Bubble Wrap




Plastic Wrap


Sponge - Paint a sponge and stamp with it






Stamp - Paint an object like bubble wrap and stamp with it







Salt - Sprinkle salt into wet paint, let it dry, and brush away the salt





Stipple - Use a toothbrush and your finger to splatter the paint
